Anil K. Gupta is widely recognized as one of the world's leading experts on strategy and globalization. He is the Ralph J. Tyser Professor of Strategy and Organization at the Smith School of Business, The University of Maryland at College Park. He received a doctorate from Harvard Business School, an M.B.A. from the Indian Institute of Management at Ahmedabad, and a B.Tech. from the Indian Institute of Technology at Kanpur.

Gupta is the author, coauthor, or coeditor of over seventy papers and three books: *The Quest for Global Dominance* (Jossey-Bass, 2008), *Smart Globalization* (Jossey-Bass, 2003), and *Global Strategy and Organization* (John Wiley, 2003). *Financial Times* has published four of Gupta's papers in a series on "Mastering Global Business." *The Wall Street Journal* has also published an invited full-page article by Gupta on "Getting China and India Right." His new book titled *The Battle for China and India* will be published by Jossey-Bass/Wiley in January 2009.

The recipient of numerous awards for excellence in research and teaching, Gupta has been recognized by *Business Week* as an Outstanding Faculty in its *Guide to the Best B-Schools*, inducted into the *Academy of Management Journals' Hall of Fame*, and ranked by *Management International Review* as one of the "Top 20 North American Superstars" for research in strategy and organization.

Gupta serves regularly as a keynote speaker at major conferences and corporate forums in the United States, Europe, China, and India. He has also served as a consultant, adviser and/or executive education faculty on strategy and globalization with some of the largest corporations in the world including IBM, National Semiconductor, Marriott, First Data, Monsanto, ABB, Lockheed Martin, McGraw-Hill, Indian Oil, McCormick, TeliaSonera, Metso, UPM-Kymmene, Finnair, Cemex, Penoles, and the IRI Group.

Gupta is an elected member of the board of directors of NeoMagic Corporation (NASDAQ, a semiconductor company) and Origene Technologies (a high flying gene cloning company). He has earlier served on the boards of directors of Omega Worldwide (NASDAQ, an asset management company), Vitalink Pharmaceutical Services Inc. (NYSE), and TiE-DC, the premier organization of entrepreneurs and venture capitalists dedicated to fostering entrepreneurship in the Mid-Atlantic region. He is also a member of the board of advisors for Asia Silicon Valley Connection (San Mateo, CA), RavGen (a Maryland-based biotechnology venture), and India Globalization Capital.

Gupta has also served as a visiting professor at Stanford University, Dartmouth College, Bocconi Business School (Milan, Italy), Helsinki School of Economics and Business Administration (Finland), and IPMI (Jakarta, Indonesia). He has been quoted by *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Washington Post*, *USA Today*, *China Daily*, *China Business News*, *India Today*, *The Times of India*, *Red Herring*, *ComputerWorld*, *CIO Magazine* as well as other leading media in Finland, Italy, India, and China. Gupta is listed in "Who's Who in America" and has served as an advisor to the US-India Business Council.
