## Information on Studying Abroad in Business Honors

Business Honors students who wish to study abroad should consider a winter or summer study abroad program in lieu of a semester program, especially if starting Honors the Fall of junior year. Completion of a Business Honors short-term study abroad program can substitute for one of the Honors course requirements (when offered).

Students who wish to complete a semester program abroad should focus on the spring of Junior year, or, in some cases, the spring of sophomore year. Students planning to study abroad in spring of Sophomore year should ensure that they will have completed BMGT221 before going abroad or while abroad, since BMGT221 must be completed before entry into the program. Students in the Honors Program are not able to study abroad in either the fall semester of their junior (if entering the program that semester) or fall semester of their senior year due to course requirements during these semesters.

Course sequencing for study abroad in spring of Junior year would be as follows (if starting the program Fall of Junior year):

When in doubt, talk to your academic advisor or the Honors staff director well in advance of studying abroad to ensure you will be able to complete the program.

\*BMGT364 is a prerequisite to BMGT495 and should be completed prior to taking BMGT495H.
