



QUEST CURRICULUM AND COURSEWORK

Information for Cohorts 33 and above

QUEST's Five-Course Curriculum

QUEST students are required to complete four core courses and one elective. Students who complete all five courses will earn a notation on their transcript.

1. Four Required Core Courses

These courses are required for all QUEST students and are taken in sequence by cohort.

*Students may appeal to take the 3-credit courses in the same semester if they are planning to study abroad or co-op.

2. One Elective Course

Students may choose from any of the 3-credit courses below.** This course may be taken any time prior to graduation.

- Re-order the sequence of the BMGT438A/ENES489A and BMGT/ENES 390H courses
- Take the BMGT438A/ENES489A and BMGT/ENES 390H courses concurrently
- Substitute another course/set of experiences for their elective course
